**B.** The recipient of the **12th FELA Award** for Innovative Literacy Promotion in Europe will be announced at the 23rd European Conference on Literacy at the beginning of the second plenary session in Crete on June 25, 2024.







The FELA Awards committee recommended that the **2024 FELA Award** for Innovative Literacy Promotion in Europe be awarded to the project **Words Matter**, supporting adolescent literacy in rap workshops nominated by FinRA.

The project focuses on groups of adolescent students within different educational settings, vocational schools, special education groups, and prisons. Supporting literacy competence through rap lyrics and music, an art form with which these groups are familiar, may give the participants a new, useful perspective on the use of language and literacy and increase their motivation for reading.


The project has been spread to more than 10,000 students in over 60 workshops so far, and a Teachers' Guide, built on the experiences from the project, makes it available to all groups of students.
